



## How to Install the Resume Writing Add-On Custom Instructions

**Note:** You will get far superior results from this Resume Writing Add-On if you merge your intelligence with AI and build an AI clone, rather than just using generic AI and creating a custom GPT or Claude project.

Not only is the complete foundational AI clone free, but you're joining a community of like-minded people who would rather build something than aimlessly doomscroll on social, thus the name Build Don't Scroll.

Important: This add-on requires your Foundation Clone to function properly. Without it, the AI only has generic information to work with, and your results will be no better than basic ChatGPT resume prompts.

### Recommended Order:

1. Complete your Foundation Clone first (free at [builddontscroll.com/skool](https://builddontscroll.com/skool))
2. Complete the LinkedIn Profile Optimizer second. Set up guide and system in the other zip file.
3. Install this Resume Writing Add-On third

### Setup Instructions

#1. You'll see two files: one is the custom instructions, and the other is the guide.

#2. The guide is a PDF document that serves as your checklist and explains the research behind the system. You can read over it to better understand what we're trying to do and why each step matters. Reading the guide is optional but recommended.

#3. The second document is the custom instructions. You can open these with any text editor, such as Notepad on PC, and TextEdit on Mac.

#4. Create a new custom GPT in ChatGPT or a new project in Claude. (By the way, I highly recommend that you use Claude as it gives the best results and we've done massive testing on both.)

#5. Copy the custom instructions into your project or custom GPT, name it "Resume Writing Add-On," and save everything.

#6. Make sure your Foundation Clone is loaded in the same project.

## **How to Use**

First Time:

1. Have your current resume ready to paste
2. Have your completed LinkedIn profile text ready to paste
3. Copy the full job advertisement (not just the link)
4. Type START to begin
5. Follow the step-by-step process, reviewing and approving each section

Returning (After First Application):

1. Paste your Resume Application Profile (created at the end of your first session)
2. Type CONTINUE
3. Paste the new job advertisement
4. Follow the tailoring process for the new position

## **Time Investment**

- First application: 30-45 minutes (includes setup and profile creation)
- Subsequent applications: 20-30 minutes each

This is NOT a "push button, get resume" system. The time you invest in reviewing and humanizing each section is what makes your resume stand out from the generic AI output that hiring managers detect in 20 seconds.
